



The February 2000 van crash agree continues to haunt the team, but rights also inspires it. At the NCAA the se Outdoor Track and Field Cham- state. pionships this week, the Panthers that t finished a surprising fourth in the declin 400-meter relay. Lewis Turner, whose younger brother Jerome Jackson was killed in the accident, also advanced to Saturday's 100 final.

"It means a lot, because we weren't expected to be doing what we're doing," Turner said "We came from a long ways back.

Coach Hoover Wright is making his own comeback. He had broken ribs, a dislocated shoulder and an injured back from the accident, and did not return to coaching until last fall. He'll turn 73 next month — eight years past Com retirement — but he did not want propo which he calls the best he's seen during his 40 years at Prairie

"I imagined some are still that s thinking about what happened, Elkh because I know I think about it a lot," Wright said. "But we man- Amer aged to overcome it."

The van was near the East Texas town of Karnack, about 150 miles east of Dallas, when the wreck happened. Nine athletes, coach Wright and assistant coach Clifton Gilliard were on their way to Pine Bluff for an indoor meet.

Houston Watson, a middledistance runner and hurdler, was driving the van, as he often did for short trips. About 7 p.m. on a rural two-lane road, a car slowed in front of the van and signaled to turn left. The van swerved right, then left, and rolled into a ditch.

Watson, 21, was pinned inside the van and died instantly, as did Samuel Sturns, 20; and Vernon James, 18. Jackson, 21, died later at a hospital. Edmonson had been dozing in
