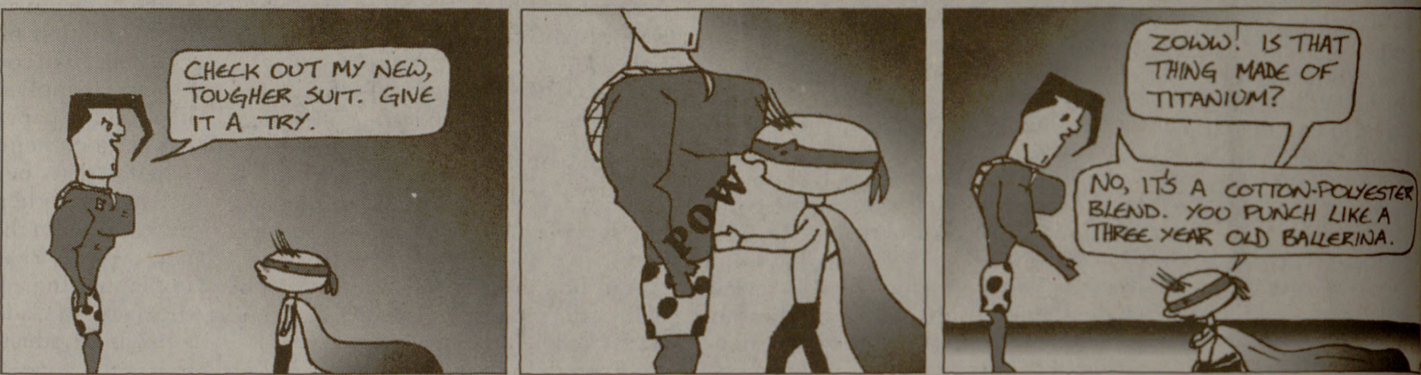

"I don't think there are words in any language that can describe what has happened," said the minister, Byron Fike. "Our hearts are filled with questions, but there are not many answers."

Yates said nothing about the capital murder charge pending against his wife. She remains

jailed without bond and was not present for the service. More charges could follow, and prosecutors are considering whether to seek the death penalty, said Harris County District Attorney Chuck Rosenthal.

District Judge Belinda Hill issued a gag order Tuesday prohibiting attorneys, police officers or witnesses in the case from discussing it publicly.

Quoting unidentified sources,

Houston television station KTRK reported earlier this week that Andrea Yates is pregnant. Her defense attorney, George Parnham, told KTRK there's "no evidence to suggest" she's pregnant and since has declined comment, citing a gag order.

Harris County Sheriff's Lt. Robert Van Pelt told the Associated Press that all female inmates are given a pregnancy test during a health assessment 14

days into their incarceration. However, a test is given only if a woman indicates whether booked that she has had problems, so prescriptions can be dispensed, he said.

Houston TV station KTRK reported Tuesday that Andrea Yates was not pregnant. The Houston Chronicle said in Wednesday's edition that a pregnancy test was negative.

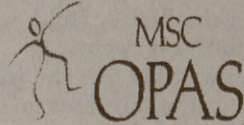
