Hospital loses removed organs

PORTLAND, Ore. (AP) — Oregon Health and Science University has apologized to the parents of a teen-ager after employees apparently lost the girl's heart and lungs removed during an au-

Stephanie Cruzen, 16, died of a heart attack Dec. 7, three years after receiving a transplanted heart to correct an inherited cardiac disorder.

Doctors at OHSU removed the organs and planned to send her heart and lungs to a specialist to pinpoint the cause of death.

'Everything would have been found in the heart and lungs," said her mother, Ann Cruzen. 'It would have told us what happened to her. Now, it's just gone."

In a July 17 letter to the Cruzens, OHSU attorney Rodney Norton said officials believe the organs were discarded by a temporary employee ee and cremated by mistake.

The Cruzens say they have filed notice of the intent to sue OHSU.
