"I entered electoral politics because I believed that there should be more women in elective office and that I could make some good," she said.

At the close of her campaign, she returned to university teaching.

Locally, VanHight received numerous awards for her support in women's and her leadership in humanitarian causes. While working in the office of University Relations at Texas A&M, she received seven awards for her development of written and audiovisual materials.

"Some people tell me I have made a difference in people's lives," she said. "I think it's time you publicly stand up for what you believe in, become a role model for others and inspire other people to do the same thing."


