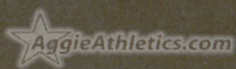

Press and edited by Charles H. Rowell. The journal should be running by this semester, and Rowell will be teaching classes during Spring 2002.

566-member part-time regiment to help prepare for the hurricane at strategic points.

A school opened Sunday morning as an emergency shelter for those living in vulnerable areas, officials said.

Police Commissioner Jonathan Smith said special preparations were being made because the hurricane was strengthening.

"We are exercising caution on this one," Smith said.

Bermuda, which lies about 560 miles off the coast of North Carolina, last had a hurricane in 1999 when Gert battered the south shore,

causing damage and knocking out power to 12,000 homes.

But unlike other islands, Bermuda — which was settled by British colonists who were shipwrecked on their way to Virginia — enjoys one of the highest average incomes in the world. Many of the homes have been built to withstand lashing hurricane-strength

bond out for the same amount as the fine plus the rant fee, he must spend an in jail and visit a judge the morning.

"We're giving people opportunity to take care of warrants before being arrested," said Bryan City Marshal Cuthbertson. "I highly recommend that they pay the fines during the amnesty period. In their own terms for less expense."

"When the amnesty period ends, law enforcement officers will aggressively pursue them and will put them in jail if they can't pay," Cuthbertson added.

While the exact number of Texas A&M students with standing warrants is unknown, Cuthbertson said it is not a high percentage of the total.

Brendan Kennedy, a senior more general studies major, received and paid a parking ticket from the city two weeks ago. He believes the amnesty period is generous.

"They're giving people a chance to get their fees taken care of," Kennedy said. "It sounds pretty fair."

Texas is a member of the Department of Public Safety's Fail-To-Appear (FTA) program.

States that are members of the program are required to notify citizens with outstanding warrants to take advantage of the amnesty period to pay outstanding fines.

Police Chief Burton said citizens with outstanding warrants to take advantage of the amnesty period to pay outstanding fines.

"[Fines] are not going away," Burton said. "I know it's got to be traumatic for citizens with warrants everytime they get in their cars to worry about being stopped and sent to jail, but they shouldn't ignore it. It will cost much more if they do."
