In a press release from the A&M Athletic Department, athletic director Wally Groff said safety measures will be taken at the gates.

"We have decided not to ban backpacks and bags, but we highly discourage fans from bringing any bags to the stadium," Groff said. "If a person must bring a bag or backpack, the gate personnel will ask the person to disclose the contents of the bag. This could create delays at the gates."

Kick-off is scheduled for 11:30 a.m., and fans are advised to arrive early. Gates will open two hours prior to kick-off. Game-day bus shuttles will be running, and information on routes can be accessed at <http://www.ptts.tamu.edu>. Riders only

will be required to show their football tickets.

The fly-overs scheduled to commemorate the Corp of Cadet's 125th anniversary have been canceled in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration regulations, according to a press release sent from the Athletic Department.

Corps Commandant Mjr. Gen. Ted Hoppood said he supports the decision to cancel the fly-overs.

"In the interest of all that is going on worldwide there will be no fly-overs, vintage or active," Hoppood said. "We have a very full plate of activities on campus with the home football game. The University of Michigan has instituted a similar restriction for their upcoming home game. I feel certain that more schools and teams will follow this early and correct decision that Texas A&M has made."

In addition to heightened security in the

immediate stadium area, Wiatt said, officers will be monitoring those areas parking in and around Kyle Game attendees are encouraged to use the game-day shuttles to the game.

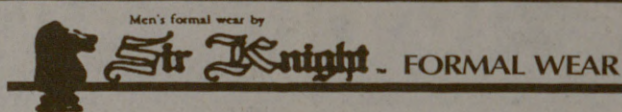
Groff encourages fans to continue show their patriotism by wearing white and blue on game day. A student effort, approved and supported by A&M administration, is calling for the first deck to wear blue, fans sitting the second deck to wear white and fans sitting in the third deck to wear red.

"Texas A&M University is known for patriotism and this is another way for us to express their commitment to the United States of America and to honor those who died by the tragedies," Groff said.

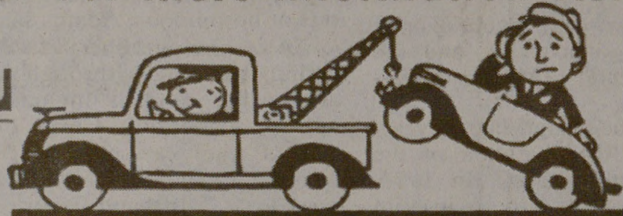
