## Labor department Senate approves hires A&M prof WASHINGTON (AP) - In a timely gesture to a key Middle East friend, the Senate on Monday

Fills Labor position as chief economis

Texas A&M economics professor Dr. Morgan O. Reynolds recently was appointed chief economist in the U.S. Department of Labor, a position that makes him third in command of the department.

Reynolds currently is on unpaid leave from the University, which allows him return to his position after one year if he chooses.

Reynolds said he did not expect the appointment but seized the opportunity when it was presented.

"People behind the recommended me, and the Bush administration gave me a call and offered me the position," Reynolds

Although this position is political assignment by the Bush administration, Reynolds said he did not angle for the position.

"They haven't had a chief economist for a while," he said. "So I am basically shaping this new role. I am just doing various things on demand right now."

Reynolds said he did not plan for this appointment to expand him into new areas.

"If I was impressing a bunch of people, some doors could open for me [following this appointment], but I'm not concerned about it because I'm just here to do the best job I

Reynolds tried to explain working Department had been like so

"My first Friday here [Sept.

7], we had 'numbers day'. is when the Bureau of La releases numbers, such as unemployment rate and emplo ment numbers," Reynolds said

The bureau announced rate at 4.9 percent, which up 0.4 percent from July African-Americans had individual unemployme rate increase of 1.2 percent August, the largest increa on the racial profile index.

Reynolds expects the ne set of numbers not to impr in the near future.

"The forthcoming nu bers are likely to be b news, but we are responding to the curre economic downturn rie now," Reynolds said.

Prior to his appointment Washington, D.C., Reynol was a professor of econon for 27 years at A&M.

"I do plan to return Texas A&M University Reynolds said.

He said that extending h unpaid leave of one year, two, is an option that he ma consider in the future.


