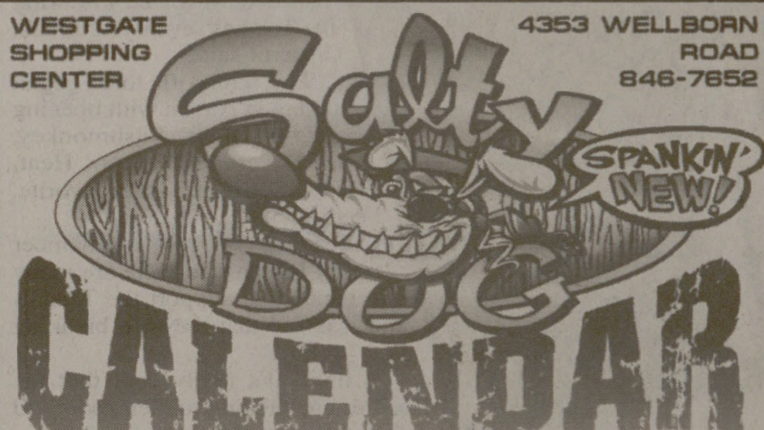

Thursday:

3rd Floor Cantina:

The local indie college band, Thanks for the Update, will perform at 9:30 p.m. There is no cover charge.

Tracy Conover, described by one Fitzwilly's employee as a "good-looking Stevie Ray Vaughn," will captivate a crowd on the outdoor stage at 9:30 p.m. Cover is \$5.

Sweet Eugene's

From 9 p.m. to midnight, latte-sipping coffeehouse guests can enjoy the soothing classic jazz sound of Big Apple Trio. Cover is \$1.

Zapatos Cantina:
