Aggies host NCAA region

Cross country team looks for good showing after Big 12 m

The Texas A&M cross country team will host the NCAA South Central Regional Saturday, Nov. 10, at the A&M Golf Course.

The Aggies are trying to qualify for the NCAA Championship which will be held in Greenville, S.C., Nov. 19. A first-place finish at the meet on Saturday would mean the Aggies could go to cross country's big dance.

A&M will compete on its own turf two weeks after the Big 12 Championships in Norman, Okla. The men finished third at the

Big 12, and the women finished fifth. In 2000, the A&M women finished first at the South Central region and became the first cross country team in A&M history to qualify for the NCAA Championships.

Standouts Andrea Bookout and Melissa Gulli helped lead the women to its first regional title last year.

The A&M men finished fourth overall in 2000's South Central Regional, making a strong performance against dominating teams. "The men's team in 1999 qualified for

NCAA for the first time in 17 years," said A&M coach Dave Hartman. "The last year we were a little down because we redshirted two
