Illinois graduate students stage two-day strike

URBANA, III. (AP) — Graduate assistants went on strike at the University of Illinois to protest the administration's refusal to recognize them as employees with the right to unionize.

The first-ever work stoppage at the Urbana-Champaign campus began with about 50 teaching assistants marching and waving handmade signs that read No Union, No Teach and The U of I works because we do.
