The Cowboys, who have used four starting quarterbacks in a season for the first time,

"What I want Quincy to do the next five weeks is grow. That's more important than anything," Campo said. "When we made the decision to go with him with the pick we did, we felt he had all of the tools. It has to be performed."

The Cowboys took Carter with their first pick last April, in the second round with the 53rd pick overall. Carter was declared the starter midway through training camp when the Cowboys released Tony Banks, now Washington's starter.

Carter played the seasonopening 10-6 loss to Tampa Bay. He then injured his thumb in practice and missed two games before tearing his hamstring in the first quarter at Oak-

land on Oct. 7. During his eight weeks away, Carter adjusted his grip on the bigger NFL football and during games intently watched other quarterbacks — the three who replaced him and those from the

opposing teams. "I thought I learned a whole lot by sitting and watching," Carter said. "I'm still a rookie. There's still so much I've got to expect Carter to also start the learn in this game."
