Oscar thief sentenced to probation

LOS ANGELES (AP) — A loading dock worker was sentenced to three years' probation for the theft of 55 Oscar statuettes just before the 2000 Academy Awards ceremony.

Anthony Hart, 40, pleaded no contest Oct. 23 to felony receiving stolen property. Superior Court Judge Terry A. Green also ordered him to pay \$200 in restitution.

Hart was a dockworker at Roadway Express in Bell, where the Oscars disappeared last year. Defense attorney Richard H. Millard said the charge against Hart can be lowered to a misdemeanor if his client remains crime-

free for 18 months. Former Roadway Express truck driver Lawrence Ledent, 39, pleaded no contest in July 2000 to felony grand theft. He was sentenced to six months in county jail, five years' probation, and ordered to pay \$51,000 in restitution. That amount included the \$50,000 reward that Akron, Ohio-based Roadway paid to the man who found 52 of the missing statuettes.

On Nov. 16, the judge also sentenced John Willie Harris, 55, to six months in jail after he pleaded no contest to receiving stolen property.

NEW YORK (AP) — The members of Destiny's Child plan to be "Independent Women" taking time off from the group to concentrate on solo projects.

Already, lead singer Beyonce Knowles has a featured role in the upcoming "Austin Powers" sequel, and Michelle Williams and Kelly Rowland have discussed solo albums.

The Grammy-winning trio has been omnipresent over the last couple of years, with back-to-back multiplatinum albums, a string of hits, dolls made in their images, a recent tour and a new holiday disc in stores.

Knowles told the E! Entertainment network that it's time for the group to go on hiatus, but they're not breaking up.

"Destiny's Child put out four albums in four years, which is unbelievable. That doesn't happen a lot," she said. "We've been working, Kelly and I, since we were 9,

nonstop. So I think Destiny's Child is going to take a little break."

Patricia Arquette discourages hate crimes

LONG BEACH, Calif. (AP) — Patricia Arquette urged a group of high school students to break free from cliques and learn more about people of different races and religions.

"Start making friends in all kinds of different places," the 33-year-old actress said. "Be-

come rich with yourself." Arquette, whose films include "True Romance" and "Stigmata," made a presentation Tuesday at Long Beach Poly High School. Her speech was part of a new program by the entertainment industry and the Los Angeles County Human Relations Commission to discourage hate crimes.

Besides school visits, Arquette and other celebrities will make public service announcements. Arquette, who was raised by a Muslim father and a Jewish mother, said she felt compelled to contact the commission and volunteer her time.

"We all have similarities," she told the students. "If you all close your eyes, what color's your blood, what color's your bones?"

NEW YORK (AP) — Hand-crafted items by stars from movies, television, music and sports will be auctioned online to help victims of the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks.

"Helping Hands II: Hand-made in America," through America Online and InStyle magazine, will raise money for those affected by the World Trade Center attacks.

Among the items up for bids: a red, white and blue portrait of Courteney Cox Arquette that her husband, David Arquette, painted; a football play that Dan Marino created, based on the American flag; and a red, white and blue Christmas ornament that John Travolta designed.

Britney Spears, Edie Falco, James Gandolfini, Ricki Lake and Mark Wahlberg are among the other stars who donated pieces they made.

The auction begins Dec. 12 and lasts through the end of the month.

P. Diddy expected to sign child support settlement Friday

NEW YORK (AP) — Sean "P. Diddy" Combs and model Kim Porter, the mother of his youngest child, have reached an agreement for support of their 3-year-old son.

Terms of the settlement — which would provide for the child, Christian Casey Combs, until he reaches age 21 — were not disclosed in court documents.

"I believe the matter is settled," Porter's lawyer, Suzanne Bracker, told hearing examiner David Kirshblum in court Wednesday. "We have a gentlemen's agreement."

The lawyers told Kirshblum they expect Combs and Porter to sign the agreement by Friday.

In comments outside court, Bracker initially described a settlement totaling more than \$4.5 million over the years. But Combs' representatives disputed that figure, calling it too high, and Bracker later said her comments were misinterpreted.

"The terms of the settlement are private," Combs said in a statement. "The welfare of my children is always my first priority, and whatever I have, they have."

Combs, 31, had been giving Porter, 30, a court-ordered \$11,000 a month, said Bracker.

Bracker estimated that Combs — who runs the Bad Boy Entertainment music publishing and recording company, has his own fashion line and owns several restaurants — earns several million dollars a year.

Combs has another son, Justin, 6, by hip-hop fashion stylist Misa Hylton-Brim, of Mount Vernon, N.Y. Combs
