"She wanted to be a Supreme Court justice," Dodson said.

Dodson said Paige's favorite drink was Mountain Dew, never finished a can.

"She didn't like it when the soda got warm, so she never finished a can," Dodson said. "I will see another Mountain Dew can and not think of her."

John Nixon, Paige's father, said his daughter loved to read; Dean Kamenovs were her favorite novels also loved movies, music was fond of her pets.

"Paige loved animals," John Nixon said. "Our family has always had dogs, cats and Paige spent a lot of time with each of them. She was home."

Penny Nixon said her middle daughter, her family and bridge gap between her two daughters, Brooke, 22, and Shelly, 20.

"A friend of ours said she was a sandwich between Paige and Shelly," Penny Nixon said.
