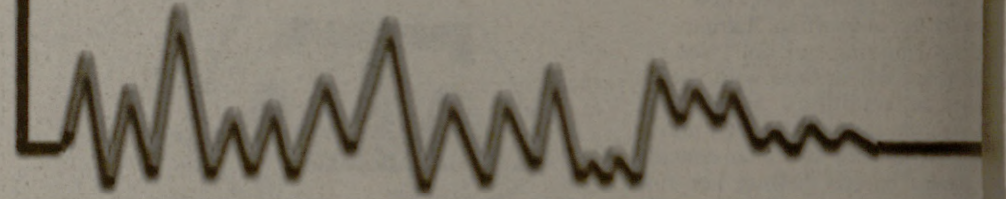
Ben Harper and The Innocent Criminals  
 Live From Mars  
 Virgin Records

As foreign as the martian atmosphere is from Earth, one similarity remains: good tunes. Apparently Ben Harper has some pull with the martian government and, through secret space travel, is allowed to entertain the locals, a populous that must share some common problems with humans. Prejudice, pain, crimes of passion and the inability to sustain meaningful romantic relationships are all relevant in martian lives; otherwise, Ben Harper would not be playing from Mars, as his music is filled to the brim with emotional and romantic confusion.

Ben Harper writes with genuine honesty, a trait hard to come by in the sentimental pop-music spectrum, and is not afraid to show his true self in all its dualistic complexity. *Live from Mars* swings from madness to sanity, pleasure to pain, tenderness to ferocity, and the double CD even expresses duality in its organization. Disc one is frantic, electric, bombastic and just plain loud, which is in direct contrast with the more passive, acoustic, probing disc two, as Harper proceeds to slash open his organic container,

allowing his soul to spill onto the martian stage. The Marvin Gaye cover, "Sexual Healing," "Steal My Kisses," "Mama's got a Girlfriend" and "Burn One Down" are liberating and celebratory, while "Please Bleed," "Faded" and "Woman in You" are fraught with torturous anger. Harper is not timid in expressing the level of pain he has experienced at the hands of an ex-girlfriend. In "Please Bleed" a frenzy to the point that all he can do is let a spine-tingling wail, harnessing his emotional baggage with an "AHHHHHHH." Harper shares his faults and failures in songs like "Alone" and "The Drugs Don't Work" the latter written by Richard Ashcroft of Verve fame.

For listeners who are not able to find martian connection or score a ticket to Ben Harper's next gig on the red planet, Ben Harper and the Innocent Criminals' *Live from Mars* will have to suffice. (Grade: A-)

**PEOPLE IN THE NEWS**

NEW YORK (AP) — Former mayor Rudolph Giuliani is out of office, but he won't be leaving the public stage soon. Giuliani's first book is due out this summer, and he is scheduled to appear in a Super Bowl television ad. Giuliani's book, titled *Leadership* and focusing on management principles, will be published June 5 by Talk Miramax. "The book is essentially the principles Giuliani has worked through, and how he has adhered to them through his career, and how they came into play in the aftermath of the World Trade Center," said Jonathan Burnham, president of Talk

Miramax Books. During the Super Bowl, Monster.com will pay for a 30-second commercial which Giuliani is expected to appear in. Americans for helping New York after terrorist attacks. "This isn't a commercial, it's a true story," said Andrew McKelvey, chairman and executive of TMP Worldwide, the job parent company. McKelvey said Giuliani wrote the script himself. Instead of paying Giuliani a fee, Monster.com is donating \$350,000 to the Twin Towers Fund, which supports families of uniformed personnel lost in the Sept. 11 attacks.
