The proof is a PGA Tour card, which Tryon secured two months ago with a 66 in the final round at Q-school to become the youngest player to ever to earn his playing privileges. He carries the card in his wallet, somewhere in there with his student ID from Dr. Phillips High School

in Orlando, Fla., where Tryon is a junior. "I've been dreaming about the PGA Tour since grade school," Tryon said, pausing to think about what he just said before finishing the thought. "Which wasn't too long ago."


