

## **Dwight Yoakam finds** singing and acting similar

LOS ANGELES (AP) – Country singer Dwight Yoakam, who plays a volatile burglar in the new movie *Panic Room*, says working in a recording studio and shooting a movie are not that different.

"They're both very fragmented," Yoakam said. "You'll start out with a master take, the whole band plays it, and then we start doing coverage of each instrument, and it's very similar to filmmaking in terms of the process, time involved and the repetition of performance."

The 45-year-old Yoakam, who played the ab boyfriend in 1996's Sling Blade, said his fi would never pick him to play a bad guy in the mo "Actors are at the mercy of the opportunities that presented to them," he said.
