"Our relationship in military aid, education and culture is a very deep one,"


Karzai said Turkey's offer to take over command of the peacekeeping force in Kabul came after lengthy negotiations with the United States and Britain. Ecevit said those discussions have resulted in agreement "to a

great extent." Britain, the cur-Afghanistan interim rent commander, prime minister wants to hand over command in April, before the mission's

mandate expires in June. Turkey -while willing to take on the mission — has insisted that its conditions be met.

Turkey has asked the United States to provide cargo planes and Britain to leave behind some of the facilities it set up for the

# Research indicates rug slows diseases

LONDON (AP) — Methotrexate, a key drug for rheumatoid itis, could help people with the crippling disease live longer, esearch suggests.

lethotrexate, originally a cancer drug, has been used to fight atoid arthritis for about 15 years. Since then it has been proven w progression of the inflammatory disease and to make patients better, but a new study provides the first hint it may also save lives. xperts said the study, published this week in The Lancet medjournal, was encouraging but did not provide definitive proof. Rheumatoid arthritis strikes about one percent of people, usually niddle age

People with the disease tend to die about 10 years sooner than noraccording to Dr. Theodore Pincus, a prominent rheumatoid ritis researcher from Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tenn. t is not the type of arthritis common in the elderly because of the

-and-tear of aging. t occurs when the immune system goes awry and attacks the s, causing severe inflammation in the lining of the joints, pain

is also linked to an increased risk of heart disease.

clentists believe people with rheumatoid arthritis have shorter spans partly because they face increased chances of getting heart se and dying from it.

The latest study, led by Dr. Frederick Wolfe of the Arthritis arch Center Foundation at the University of Kansas School of icine, found that patients on methotrexate were 60 percent less y to die prematurely than those not getting the drug.

hey were 70 percent less likely than people not on the drug to from heart disease.

perts said the finding bolsters the growing body of evidence Inflammation might play a role in heart attacks and that antimmatory mediction might ward them off.

lethotrexate works by switching off the underlying inflammacaused by the immune response.

Dr. David Scott, professor of clinical rheumatology at Guy's, s and St. Thomas' Medical School in London, said the ival findings echo what doctors have suspected.
