

There will be a reading of the victims names in remembrance on Tuesday at Rudder Fountain from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday night an interfaith memorial service will be held at Rudder Fountain at 7 p.m. Different religious groups on campus have joined together to each host a different part of the memorial service. Peyton said they tried to incorporate other religions into their display to reach all students.

"We try and bring in other perspectives, especially with all the attempts to show more diversity on our campus," Peyton said.

Students will have a chance to write down their thoughts and comments at the end of the exhibit.

Other students said they must keep the flame of remembrance alive.

"It's so important that these things are remembered," said junior Blake Walker. "Because students need to be educated, they can teach these things to their children."

Labels on malt beverage bottles to change

WASHINGTON (AP) — In an effort to clear up consumer confusion, federal regulators will forbid makers of certain flavored malt beverages from labeling and advertising them as containing vodka, rum or other liquor.

The action by the Treasury Department's Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms on Monday is aimed at the fast-growing market for "malternative" drinks. Like beer, these products have a malt base, but they are usually clear and flavored.

ATF spokesperson Jim Crandall said Miller Brewing Co.'s Sky Blue and Bacardi Silver are examples of products that would need to change their labeling to comply. He said Smirnoff, another flavored malt beverage, would not be affected because its labels do not suggest that the drink contains liquor.
