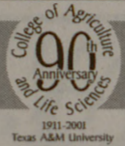

**Gunman wounds
two in Afghanistan**

KANDAHAR, Afghanistan (AP) — A gunman opened fire Wednesday on a group of U.S. troops shopping on a busy street in this former Taliban stronghold, wounding one American and an Afghan before escaping, the U.S. military and witnesses said.

Afghan officials blamed the shooting on Taliban or al-Qaida fugitives and said they feared more attacks. The shooting occurred one day before Afghanistan's former king was expected to return to the capital, Kabul, after 29 years exiled in Rome.

Witnesses said the Americans, who were wearing civilian clothes, were at a gun shop when the shots were fired. The wounded American, whose name was not released, walked to his vehicle unassisted, witnesses said. He was taken to the U.S. military hospital at Kandahar airport, where he was reported in stable condition.

The gun shop owner, who gave his name only as Daood, said one Afghan also was wounded. Another gunsmith, Mohammed Saleem, said the Americans left the scene quickly after the attack. He praised them for not opening fire on a street filled

with children who had just left school for the day. "There are still individual Taliban, al-Qaida members in the city," said Abdul Wahid, a local commander. "They were probably responsible for this. We may see more incidents in the future."

U.S. and other international officials warned for weeks that Westerners, especially Americans, were at risk from attack by Taliban and al-Qaida fugitives. The risk is greater, however, in Kabul and in provinces in the southeast where the U.S.-led coalition is fighting Taliban and al-Qaida forces.

British Royal Marines joined that effort this week, sending elite troops into the mountains along the Pakistani border to try to escape routes into Pakistan.

On Wednesday, British officers said their forces had not clashed yet with al-Qaida Taliban units. However, the Royal Marines have found thousands of rounds of ammunition, communication equipment and some weapons in caves and bunkers.

and distributes everything the team will need to be self-sufficient for three days.

Team members must live

within four hours of College Station, Martell said. All of the members are full-time working professionals including firefighters, canine specialists and medical specialists. Team members are trained to respond to emergencies year-round.

The task force is one of several teams in the Federal Emergency Management Agency designated as one of six to respond to a threat of a weapon of mass destruction. Teams were chosen based on their technical ability.
