The UIL requires its coaches to warn athletes about the dangers of drug abuse, including steroids. The information also will be sent to parents starting with the new school year, Breithaupt said.

Any coach encouraging steroid use would be violating UIL ethics rules and could face sanctions, he said.

D.W. Rutledge is assistant executive vice president at the Texas High School Coaches Association and has 27 years experience coaching high school and college football. He said his organization hasn't discussed the possibility of

think most coaches would agree that testing is a possibility,' said Rutledge, who says he never coached an athlete he thought
