## Former ImClone CEO arrested

NEW YORK (AP) — The former chief executive of ImClone Systems was arrested by the FBI on Wednesday and charged with tipping off two people to sell their stock in the biotech company a day before the FDA rejected its application for a new cancer drug.

Separately, the Securities and Exchange Commission brought civil charges against Samuel Waksal, accusing him of warning family members in advance of the bad news about the highly touted drug, Erbitux. The SEC said the family then dumped more than \$10 million in stock.

It said Waksal himself tried to sell 79,797 shares worth nearly \$5 million, but brokerage firms would not take his business.

Waksal, 54, was charged by federal prosecutors with securities fraud, conspiracy and perjury, allegedly lying to the SEC about the tips. He could get up to 2 years in prison if convicted of all four charges.

Waksal was released on \$1 million bail and had no comment as he left court. A federal magistrate ordered him to identify any money held overseas and return it to the United States by Friday.

Waksal's lawyer, Mark Pomerantz, called the prosecution's evidence "entirely circumstantial."

"The government misread the evidence and it overreacted in deciding to make today's arrest," he said.

The insider trading charge came three weeks after Waksal stepped down as head of the small New York company he founded in 1984.

ImClone's fortunes are totally dependent on Erbitux, a cancer drug that looked so promising that it led to a big run-up in the company's stock price. The stock has plummeted by 90 percent since December and down to less \$8.

Just three days before Waksal resigned, the company announced disappointing results from an Erbitux test in head and neck cancer patients.

Authorities said Waksal learned on Dec. 26 that the Food and Drug Administration would not consider ImClone's application for Erbitux.

According to prosecutors, Waksal tipped off an unidentified person in Florida to sell 50,000 shares of ImClone stock on Dec. 27, the day before the FDA actually informed the company of its decision. Waksal also allegedly told a second person, who later sold nearly 40,000 shares.

**Astronauts ready to come home**

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. (AP) — NASA's new space endurance champs, a pair of astronauts who have broken the six-month barrier, have no interest in going after the world record of more than one year.

"I'm ready to come home," spaceman Daniel Bursch, 44, said Wednesday. He said he was looking forward to a pizza.

Bursch and Carl Walz broke the U.S. space endurance record of 188 days on Tuesday night as they slept by Shannon Lucid in 1996 aboard Russia's Mir station.

**President and First Lady hope to get people exercising**

WASHINGTON (AP) — President Bush will race hundreds of White House aides next week, and hopes America's couch potato will get up and do the same — perhaps by taking advantage of free admission to national parks.

With childhood obesity growing and nearly half of American adults saying they never exercise, the president and First Lady Laura Bush are planning four days of fitness activities — on the White House lawn, at a nearby military post, and in Orlando, Fla. — for next week.
