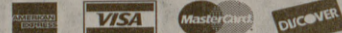

The United States shook up lineup, inserting four new starters and switching to a three-man defensive line.

Gregg Berhalter, Paul Mastroeni, Eddie Lewis and Wolf joined the starting lineup with Berhalter making his World Cup debut. Wolf, who scored against Mexico in the opener last year's final round of qualifying, had played just nine minutes in the previous three games as Lewis had played 16.

Left back Frankie Hejduk was suspended for getting two yellow cards and central defender Agoos was hurt in Friday's loss to Poland. Arena also benched Clint Mathis and Eric Stewart.

Stewart was injured in the opening 3-2 win over Portugal, missed the 1-1 tie against South Korea, and looked sluggish in Poland game. Mathis, whose fitness over 90 minutes has been questioned by Arena, also played against Portugal, which lost to Mexico game, started at 3:30 p.m. (2:30 a.m. EDT).

While Arena had gone with a 4-4-2, he switched to a 3-5-2 against the Mexicans.

Friedel remained in goal, the defense featured Berhalter, left back, Eddie Pope in the center and Tony Sanneh at right back.

The midfield had Roy O'Brien and Mastroeni in the middle, with Lewis on the left side and Donovan on the right. Wolf and McBride were the forwards.

Stewart came on as a second half sub for his 10th World Cup appearance, a record for American players.

4 a.m. Andre Flores, the Mexican-born husband, pushed his chair in quietly, eyes glistening, at the end of the match.

A table of police officers argued playfully over whether their team they should be yelling "Mexico, man," said Marisa Guerra. "Because I'm Mexican, I was born in Mexico."

Lt. Francisco Durango, the wise born in Mexico, differed. "I'm 100 percent gringo," he said. "I served in the Army. This is my country."

At the Immigration and Naturalization Service, which bent the rules and kept the television sets on, 90 percent of inmates cheered for Mexico as they were from, said David Valdez, a security guard.

"Soccer is more of a Mexican sport, Hispanic," Valdez said.

## Rice eliminated from CWS in 5-3 loss to Notre Dame

OMAHA, Neb. (AP) — Bryan Stavisky hit a two-run homer with one out in the bottom of the ninth inning to give Notre Dame a 5-3 victory over Rice Monday in a College World Series elimination game.

The Fighting Irish (50-11) reached the 50-win mark for the first time while staying alive in their second CWS appearance.

Steve Stanley started the ninth inning rally with a one-out homer and tied the game 3-3 on a solo home run by the Owls' Matt Sollmann's single up the middle. Stavisky then hit a 1-2 pitch over the fence in right as the Owls bolted from their dugout to celebrate at home plate.

Rice's Justin Crowder (10-1) who came on in relief with two outs in the third and had allowed just two hits until the last ninth-inning rally, took the loss.

Austin Davis had a solo home run and RBI single for the Owls (14), who were two outs away from advancing after taking the first lead in the seventh on a homer by Omaha native Matt Lorschbach. J.P. Gagne allowed the tiebreaking pinch-hit homer, but held on to win.

Notre Dame starter Greg Niessel allowed just two runs, six hits in 6 2-3 innings, but pulled with two outs and no one on in the seventh for Gagne's move backfired when Lorschbach hit his fifth homer of the series, which barely cleared the wall left center.
