champion, showcased its speed and flair in the second half of the 2-0 win over Belgium. Brazil, which struggled to qualify, the only team from the South American confederation in quarterfinals.

England had little trouble beating Denmark 3-0, advancing to face Brazil in the anticipated matchup of quarterfinals.

But the other big names do not have it so easy.

"This World Cup does have some quite extraordinary results," German coach Joachim Voeller said. "There are more small countries. Anybody can beat anybody."

His 2002 U.S. Open victory made him the first person to ever lead the Open from start to finish twice, having accomplished the same feat in 2000.

He is the first player in 30 years to win the first two events of the Grand Slam and is only the second player in the history of the game to hold all four major championship trophies at the same time, winning the U.S. Open, British Open, and PGA Championship in 2000 and The Masters in 2001 to complete what has become known as "The Tiger Slam."

The scariest part of all is the fact that Tiger has accomplished so much so soon. At the age of 26, Woods stands to play at least 15 to 20 more years of competitive golf, giving him 45 to 60 appearances at major events, needing only 10 to catch Jack Nicklaus' seemingly untouchable record of 18 major titles.

Considering that Tiger has won seven of the last 11 major championships, it seems that he would take a divine intervention to prevent it from happening because the rest of the golfing world today have not found an answer for the "Tigerizing" of the game.

The game of golf has benefited more than anyone could have ever imagined since Tiger first joined the tour in 1996. The TV contracts are more lucrative; the endorsements show no sign of slowing. Many believe that Woods will break the \$100 million mark in endorsements within the next few years, a number that was unheard of for anyone but Michael Jordan only five years ago.

Will Tiger win the British Open and PGA Championship this year to complete the second grand slam in the history of the game? Maybe. But even if he comes up short, there is not another golfer in the world that can consistently compete with Woods, and there is not another player in the world that can win a championship just about any day he feels like it.
