cooperative education internships at Texas A&M career center, said despite economic downturn, employment opportunities are still available for graduates.

"Overall, many of our students in engineering, accounting, computer science and liberal arts are being recruited," she said. Boerma said students need to understand the realities of current job market for the field, which means fewer offers, and for less prestigious jobs at lower pay and with greatly reduced extra incentives.

"They need to realize they may not get their dream job or dream location, but at least they are getting employed," Boerma said. "The might have to start off in a less-than-ideal position in their chosen field or work their way up for many years in the organization."

Pleasant wants to go into broadcasting, and said he started sending resumes to television stations as early as March. "I'm still looking and have become a little discouraged. It just not going to give up," Pleasant said. "I will continue to be persistent, and all I can do is pray that things fall my way soon."

"I worked very hard to get college degree and I want to be able to use it," he said. The bad economy is also effecting students who are trying to find part-time work over summer jobs.

Christina Rodriguez, a senior history major, struggled just to find a summer job in College Station. Rodriguez said she sent applications to 15 retail stores at Post Oak Mall in College Station in early May and has not heard from any of the employers yet.

"I was very frustrated because my money situation was getting desperate," Rodriguez said. "I wish the places I applied for more aware of my situation. It would be more considerate getting back to me and letting me know if they had any openings."

Rodriguez finally got hired for a job she applied for online. She is now going to work for Martin & Associates, a company that sells Cutco products. "I applied online on June 10 and within two hours they had contact with me, and I was interviewed four days later and hired," Rodriguez said.

Boerma said using campus resources will certainly help seniors find jobs in time before graduation.

"Utilize all of the resources available at the career center. All of the networks you have. I'll leave that to others. The main issue here should be people at issues, and should have good job program instead of. However, responsibility is on the other side of the coin. People are fighting and we are not making any headway."

10 Pakistani soldiers killed in gun battle
ISLAMABAD, Pakistan (AP) - Acting on U.S. intelligence, Pakistani soldiers raided an Afghan Qaida hide-out near the border, setting off a gun battle that killed 10 Pakistani soldiers and two suspected members of the terror network, officials said Wednesday.

A 15-year-old foreign boy captured following the four-hour battle, which began late Tuesday near the border town of Wazir, Pakistani officials said. However, most of the fighters, believed to be Chechens, escaped in the darkness early Wednesday.
