

the nationally ranked College of Engineering, which has over 300 tenured faculty members, 7,628 undergraduate students, and over 1,974 graduate students.

Kellett said the University and the search committee is now in the process of scheduling campus visits with faculty, staff and students during the next four to five weeks.

"[After all five candidates interview on campus], Chancellor Howard D. Graves will forward his recommendations to the Board of Regents,' Kellett said.

Howard will also be working with incoming University President Dr. Robert Gates and interim Provost David Prior.

The nine member Board of Regents will then vote on the finalists and make the final appointment.

Kellett said the next Regents meeting is scheduled for July 25-26. She said the search committee is not sure if the Regents will vote on the finalists during the July meeting because the schedule of interviews has not been finalized.

"The schedule of interviews will probably be announced tomorrow," she said. "So I am not sure if it will come up at the next meeting."
