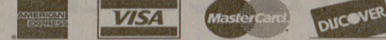

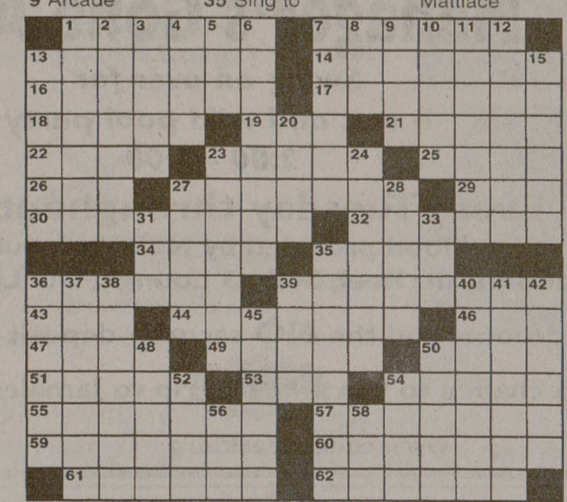

NEWS IN BRIEF

Traffic on 3 streets will be rerouted Wednesday

Traffic on Wellborn between George Bush and Old Main Drive will be rerouted Wednesday. Temporary barricades will be relocated altering the lanes in both directions.
Vaughn Construction N-Line Traffic Maintenance urged drivers to exercise caution while driving near Wellborn Road this week because workers will be on the roads while implementing the changes.
The changes were originally set to occur on Sunday, but heavy rains in the area more rain on Wednesday changes could be delayed again.

Border Patrol seizes \$8.5 million worth of cocaine

FALFURRIAS, Texas (AP) — U.S. Border Patrol agents seized about \$8.5 million worth of cocaine concealed in a false compartment of a pickup truck, the Border Patrol said Monday.
Border Patrol agents working at the traffic checkpoint south of Falfurrias discovered the drugs after inspecting the vehicle about 9:40 p.m. Friday.
Juan Carlos Rodriguez-Ruiz, 33, of Mission and a 38-year-old female passenger from San Juan were arrested.
Rodriguez-Ruiz was charged with possession with intent to distribute cocaine, and his detention hearing was set for Thursday in magistrate court in Corpus Christi.
While at the primary inspection point, a Border Patrol dog alerted authorities to the dog of the truck. Further inspection revealed a secret compartment in the bed containing about 264 pounds of cocaine.
Both suspects, the vehicle and the cocaine were turned over to the Drug Enforcement Administration in Corpus Christi.

Smith County man charged for fraude scheme

BEAUMONT, Texas (AP) — Smith County man has been charged with dozens of counts of fraud in what federal authorities said was a marketing scheme run from his home near Overton.
Allen Petty Jr., 68, is known as Al Petty, was indicted on 78 counts of wire fraud, mail fraud and money laundering, according to a release issued by the attorney for the Eastern District of Texas after an indictment was unsealed Monday.
No one answered the telephone at Petty's home Monday night.
He was indicted by a federal grand jury on Wednesday.
Petty is accused of operating TeleCom2000 Network "businesses" throughout the world by guaranteeing substantial returns on investments, the release states.

Rubber asphalt used on road

ALAMOGORDO, N.M. (AP) — The rubber meets the road between Alamogordo and Paso, Texas.
Rubberized asphalt has been used to pave a 56-mile, four-lane expansion of Interstate 54 between the two cities.
It's the first time rubberized asphalt has been used on a road project in New Mexico, said Kathie Leyendecker, spokeswoman for the Transportation Department.
The rubber is from recycled tires.
"By using retired tires from New Mexico, we have diverted about 1.5 million pounds, or 100,000 tires, from going to landfills," said Department Secretary Pete Rahm.
