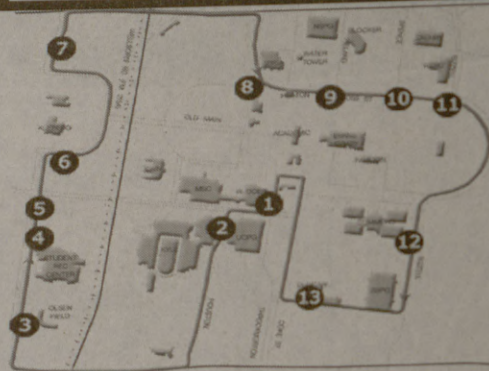

If your hall change request is approved, you will be required to move by 9 p.m. on Sunday, September 8th.

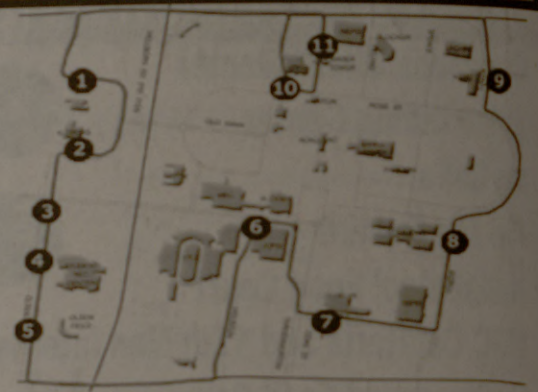
September 2nd will be the only time to request a hall change for Fall 2002.
