compliance departments in the nation, he said.

"I think we have some good things going for the program," said Groff. "The future is bright for athletics here at Texas A&M."

Groff started as a business manager in the A&M Athletic Department in December 1966. He was promoted to assistant ath-

letic director for business affairs in 1975 and then to associate athletic director of finance in 1979. He was named second-in-command in 1988. Groff served as interim athletic director in 1981-82 and also in 1993. He was named athletic director August 31, 1993.

Groff said his plans for the future aren't set. "I would like to stay here in some capacity," Groff said. "I'm an Aggie. I've been an Aggie since I came here as a freshman in 1966, so I'm going to eventually retire here and support these coaches of these teams."
