#### New York City police union gets contract, raise

NEW YORK (AP) - The city's police officers were given an 11.5 percent raise over two years by a state arbitration panel, a ruling that was praised by the union but criticized by

The police union, which had sought a 23 percent pay hike over two years, said the decision by a Public Employees Relations Board panel in Albany represented a victory.


