**'Osbournes' second season coming soon**

LOS ANGELES (AP) — The Ozzy Osbourne clan could return to MTV as early as November with the second season of their hit reality show.

The Osbournes' chronicles the lives of the heavy metal legend, his feisty wife, Sharon, and two of their teenage children — daughter Kelly, and son Jack.

MTV President Brian Graden says "all systems are go" for the show. However, the network may still decide to postpone the show, possibly to January, MTV spokeswoman Vanessa Reyes said.

The series became MTV's biggest hit ever last year, showcasing the offbeat antics of the family as Ozzy, a former drug abuser and self-proclaimed "Prince of (bleeping) Darkness," and his wife, who's also his longtime manager, dealt with the complexities of parenthood.

Details on the upcoming shows were not released and the debut date was not specified Tuesday.

The season is expected to feature Sharon Osbourne's battle against cancer as she undergoes chemotherapy sessions. She was diagnosed with colorectal cancer July 1, after her husband urged her to see a doctor for a long overdue checkup. Two days later, she had surgery; one of two lymph nodes that were removed tested positive for cancerous cells, indicating the disease had spread.

Meanwhile, Kelly Osbourne has tried to launch her own musical career this summer with her cover of the Madonna single "Papa Don't Preach." Jack Osbourne has made cameo appearances on TV shows including "Dawson's Creek."

The family also has taken in a teenage friend of the family, Robert Marcato, whose mother died of the same type of cancer afflicting Sharon.

**Nick Nolte charged with misdemeanors**

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Prosecutors filed two misdemeanor counts Wednesday against actor Nick Nolte in connection with his September arrest for allegedly driving under the influence.

Nolte, 61 faces charges of driving under the influence and being under the influence of a controlled substance, said Sadie Gibbons, spokeswoman for the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

Tests indicated Nolte had elements of the banned depressant gamma hydroxybutyrate in his system, she said.

Known as GHB, the drug comes in liquid, powder or pill

form. It became a popular club drug because of its ability to cause euphoria. The drug can also cause loss of consciousness, which led to its abuse as a date-rape drug. Nolte checked into a Connecticut rehabilitation center on Sept. 14, just days after his arrest. An arraignment was scheduled Monday in Malibu. If convicted, he could serve up to six months in jail.

Nolte had been driving his black 1992 Mercedes-Benz, swerving into oncoming highway lanes, when he was stopped Sept. 11 near his west Malibu home, police said. The arresting officer described Nolte as disheveled and drooling during the traffic stop along the Pacific Coast Highway. Nolte had a reputation as a heavy drinker for years, once describing himself as a "functioning drunk." But in the mid-1990s he reportedly quit alcohol and became a fitness buff. He was nominated for Oscars for 1991's *The Prince of Tides* and 1997's *Affliction*.

**Jordan files lawsuit against woman**

CHICAGO (AP) — Michael Jordan filed a lawsuit Wednesday claiming a woman was trying to extort \$5 million from him to keep quiet about a relationship they had more than 10 years ago.

The basketball star acknowledged in the lawsuit that he had had a relationship with the woman and paid her \$250,000 "under threat of publicly exposing that relationship."

But Jordan, who plays for the Washington Wizards but spent most of his career with the Chicago Bulls, said he never agreed to pay any more than \$250,000.

Jordan's attorney, Fred Spierling, refused to say whether the athlete took the allegations to the police. He also refused to answer any questions about the nature of the relationship.

"The complaint says everything Michael has to say," Spierling said. Jordan and his wife, Juanita, have been married more than 12 years. She filed for divorce last January. But the Jordans withdrew the divorce case one month later and said they were attempting a reconciliation.

**New Faith Hill CD Cry debuts at No. 1**

NEW YORK (AP) — Faith Hill has no reason to shed a tear — her new album, *Cry* debuted at No. 1.

*Cry* sold about 472,000 copies during its first week in stores, according to industry figures released Wednesday.

The country singer knocked Elvis Presley from the top spot of the album chart, where he's been the past three weeks. *Elvis 30 No. 1 Hits* has gone platinum, selling more than 1.1 million copies.
