Texas filmmaker looks close to home with 'Hell House'

DALLAS (AP) — Whether it's a Dallas-area church's haunted house or the film that documents its creation, "Hell House" draws fiery reactions.

Some who've seen director George Ratliff's movie suggest he should have taken shots at the congregation that recreates the evangelistic house each October. Others fervently support members of Trinity Church of Cedar Hill, whose Hell House has featured scary scenes of AIDS deaths, botched abortions and a Columbine-style school shooting.

The movie contains no narration and follows organizers and teenage cast members as they gleefully prepare and then put on what has been described as a high-tech, fire-and-brimstone sermon — an attempt to frighten Halloween visitors into making a religious commitment before they leave the premises.

"What you're going to see in Hell House is a reality check," church youth minister Tim Ferguson tells viewers at the beginning of the 85-minute film. Trinity, an Assembly of God church in suburban Dallas, is featuring its twist on the Halloween haunted house for the 12th straight year this month. The popularity of such "hell houses" has spread to churches across the country.

Teens who attend the church or an affiliated school go through intense competition for roles that include a gay man dying from AIDS, a girl bleeding to death from an abortion and a rave where a girl is raped and commits suicide with a razor blade.

Throughout the house, demons stand by to drag sinners to hell, the tour's final destination. "Now it's time for your eternal trip," one tells a teen who shoots himself to death in a classroom.

fumble and sprinted 66-yards for a touchdown giving the Aggies a 31-14 lead. The touchdown was the final score of the night for the Aggies.

Nebraska answered quickly with a three-play, 68-yard drive that was capped off by a 21-yard touchdown run broken down the right sideline by Horne to bring the Huskers within 10.

"I think that (Nebraska) drive was the turning point," Gamble said. "I thought Byron's play was a big momentum shift and that we could ice the game from that point, but we were a little winded and had to get right back out on the field, and their score took some wind out of us."

In the Aggie drive following another Nebraska touchdown bringing the score within three, the Cornhusker defense came up big by sacking Long for a loss of 15 yards on first down and forcing junior punter Cody Scates' 14-yard punt, giving the Cornhuskers the ball at the A&M 35-yard line.

"The defense felt like we played good the whole game," said Nebraska linebacker Demorrio Williams. "Coming in the Blackshirts were going up against the Wrecking Crew and the best unit would win. Once we got the offense on the field we knew we would get the ball in the end zone."

Nebraska took advantage of the field position to run the ball

on six consecutive plays taking 46 seconds off of the clock and scoring a touchdown to claim its first lead since the first quarter, 35-31. Horne scored his fourth touchdown of the night on the option.

Nebraska would add another field goal coming off of Long's first interception of the game with six minutes remaining in the contest, and a late A&M drive was put down when Long threw an interception into the end zone with 2:23 left in the game.

"Nebraska and Tech are two different styles of teams," Slovic said. "I never felt comfortable throughout the game tonight in stopping their offense. It's very disappointing to lose three times at home this year."
