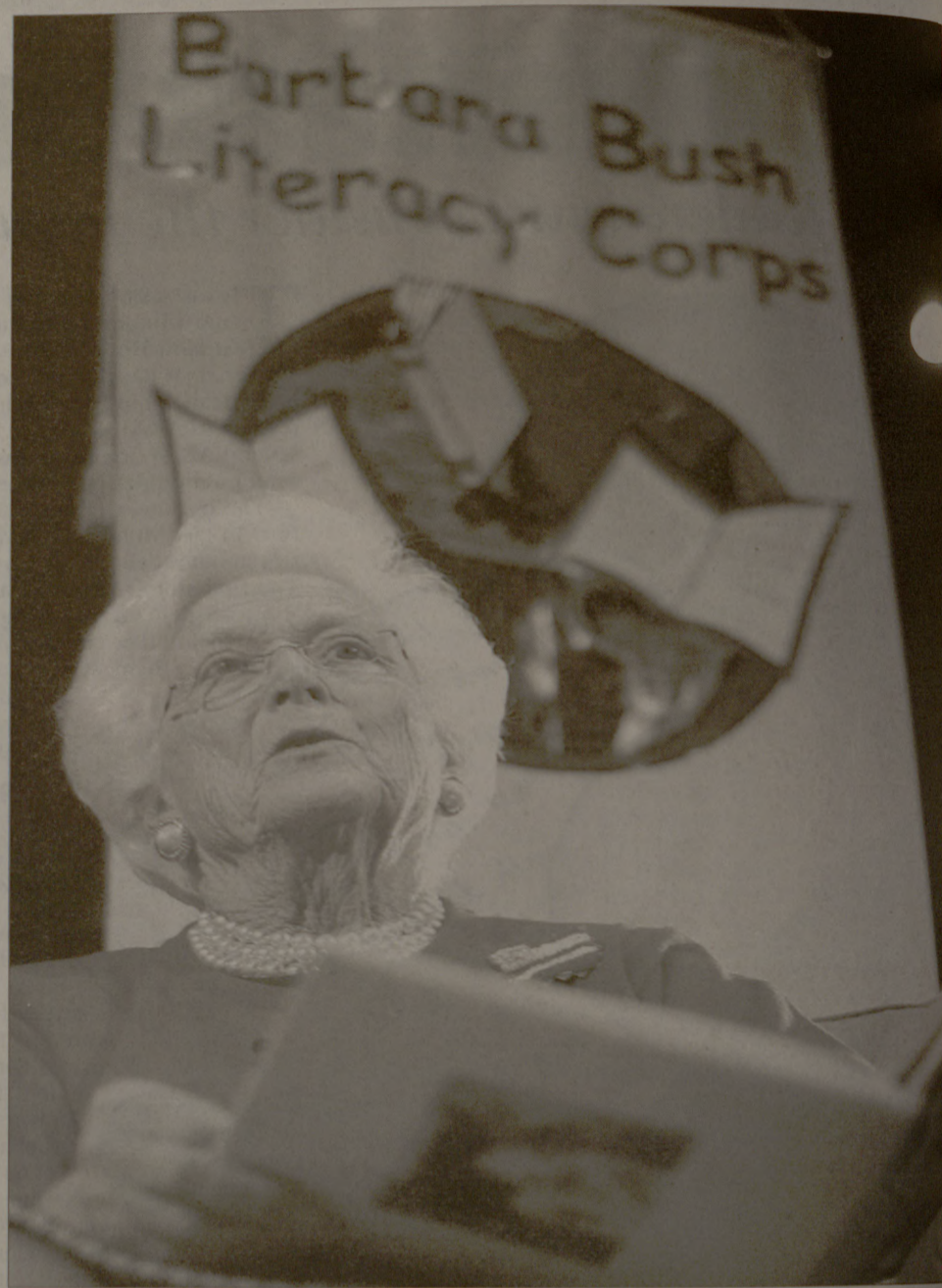

##### Bush officials waiting for Iraq to disarm

WASHINGTON (AP) — War plans in hand, Bush administration officials on Sunday promised "zero-tolerance" if Saddam Hussein refuses to comply with international calls to disarm.

A new U.N. Security Council resolution demands that Iraq eliminate its weapons of mass destruction and open up to inspectors or face "serious consequences."

Under the resolution, the

Security Council would assess any violations and decide how to respond. But several administration officials made plain that the United States reserved the right to invade Iraq with or without U.N. approval.

##### State companies stay in China's economy

BEIJING (AP) — Even as foreign investment floods in and private enterprise flourishes, state-owned companies will remain central to China's novel mix of

socialism and capitalism. Economic officials said Sunday the sidelines of their state Communist Party Congress.

"We would persist in building an economic system in which public ownership is the mainstay," Zeng Peiyan, minister of the State Development Planning Commission, said at a news conference.

He and others did say, though, that the state companies that remain will be made as profitable and efficient as private enterprises.
