**8 Mile**  
Eminem, Kim Basinger, Brittany Murphy

Controversial rapper Eminem makes his acting debut in *8 Mile*, a gritty and inspiring tale of an impoverished young man's fears and fight to realize his hopes of fame and fortune.

Jimmy Smith Jr. (Eminem), nicknamed "Rabbit," is a white-trash factory worker who lives with his troubled mother (Kim Basinger) and his little sister in a dilapidated Detroit trailer park on 8 Mile Road, which divides the suburbs from the inner city.

In this semi-autobiographical story of urban survival, Rabbit is an aspiring rapper, scribbling lyrics on napkins. At one point, Rabbit raps to the tune of Lynyrd Skynyrd's "Sweet Home Alabama" while repairing his junk car with a friend.

After choking with fear during a debut performance at The Shelter, a hip-hop club, Rabbit seeks to muster the courage to face the hostile audience again. While subduing his own personal demons, he must confront his mother's abusive boyfriend, a rival rap group bent on vengeance and a close friend's bitter betrayal.

As his life spirals downward, Rabbit finds bittersweet inspiration from a young aspiring model (Brittany Murphy), who also dreams of escaping Detroit. After his friend's promises of a record deal fall through, Rabbit realizes the difference between the idle pipe dreams of youth and real opportunities to "seize the music, the moment," as the movie's theme song says. Shining moments include Rabbit defending a gay factory worker, caring for his little sister and facing his fears of public performance.

Both fans and critics of the contentious rapper can enjoy *8 Mile* and Eminem's soulful portrayal of an underprivileged rapper's struggle to survive and take a first step toward seeing his dreams come true.

**Femme Fatale**  
Rebecca Romijn-Stamos, Antonio Banderas

Nothing seems more enticing than a supermodel and a sexy man ripping apart Brian de Palma's new film, *Femme Fatale*. The first 15 minutes of the movie is almost without dialogue and turns out to be the most captivating part.

Romijn-Stamos clearly looks the part of a beautiful woman caught in an elaborate web of theft, lies and double-crossing, but her acting falls flat. Banderas is cast as a sexy photographer, and although he pulls it off, there is little development of his character. Most of the supporting characters are one-dimensional and provide no relief.

In some scenes, the dialogue is so unrealistic that the drama can be foiled by the audience's laughter. Even the European location can't save the film — most of the shots are indoors.

Although the two stars are good-looking enough to maintain attention span, the twists and turns of the plot eliminate any sense of real life. The storyline leads seven years into the future and leaves giant holes where explanations should be.

When the end finally arrives, the plot hasn't filled in any holes or provided any explanations. By the final scenes, the acting remains less-than-stellar and the lines become even cheesier. The only thing which salvages the end is that the movie is over.
