## NEWS IN BRIEF

### Drastic restrictions on asylum seekers rejected after vote

GENEVA (AP) — Voters on Sunday rejected stringent new asylum laws that would have closed the nation's borders to all but a trickle of refugees, defeating the nationalist proposal by the thinnest margin in Swiss voting history.

The defeat by 2,754 votes was a victory for the government and the U.N. refugee agency but served to highlight growing anti-immigration sentiment in Europe.

In the end, 50.1 percent of voters, or 1,120,967 people, rejected the proposed law, and 49.9 percent, or 1,118,213, were in favor. Voter turnout was 46.7 percent.

The plan "against abuse of the right to asylum," drawn up by hard-line members of the Swiss People's Party, would have expelled refugees arriving via any persecution-free country — in practice, all of Switzerland's neighbors.

The government had worried the law would set the neutral nation on a collision course with the rest of Europe and endanger its humanitarian traditions.

### Mold in schools causes health, financial problems

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — To protest a menace in their school, nearly 1,000 students at East High School in Memphis skipped homework one day.

Across the state, another 1,000 students spent a month at Bristol Motor Speedway — not watching NASCAR races, but studying in the skyboxes while a threat was removed at Sullivan East High School.

In each case, the problem was the same: mold.

Nationwide, school districts are finding allergy-inducing mold in walls, on carpets and near ventilation systems. While one report blames aging buildings and mold-promoting construction techniques, one expert says it's due to a lack of proper ventilation in newer schools.

### Skid row sweeps raise tensions in Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES (AP) — After 21 years living amid the tent encampments of downtown Los Angeles, friends call Tyrone Taylor the "Mayor of Skid Row."

These days, the mayor is not happy.

On two afternoons last week, police officers, accompanied by correction officials and federal agents, made an estimated 200 arrests on Skid Row.

They said they were targeting parole and probation violators hiding amid the homeless. But Taylor and others fear police are moving to take them off the streets.
