Federal agents shut down lottery scam

CONCORD, N.H. (AP) — Federal agents say they have broken up a scheme based in Canada that defrauded elderly victims across the United States

out of more than \$5 million by telling them they had won a lottery jackpot.

Authorities have recovered \$4.5 million from Israeli and Jordanian banks, U.S. Attorney Thomas Colantuono said Tuesday.

Fifteen Canadians were arrested Tuesday in Montreal on charges of racketeering and conspiracy to commit mail fraud. They are to stand trial in New Hampshire, where one of their earliest victims lives, Colantuono said.
