Williams begins clearing up Astros' lineup status

KISSIMMEE, Fla. (AP) - Five days before their first spring training game in the Grapefruit League, the Houston Astros lineup is taking shape.

Team Manager Jimy Williams has named center fielder Craig Biggio as the likely lead-off hitter while shortstop Julio Lugo should be batting second. Williams said first baseman Jeff Bagwell probably

will have the third spot in the lineup, while outfielder Lance Berkman will bat clean-up followed by newly acquired second baseman Jeff Kent batting in the fifth position.

Williams has even named Roy Oswalt the starting pitcher for the Astros' opening day game at Minute Maid Park in Houston on April 1 against the Colorado Rockies.

Williams said he can see many players filling leadership roles this year.

"We're not looking for a speaker of the


