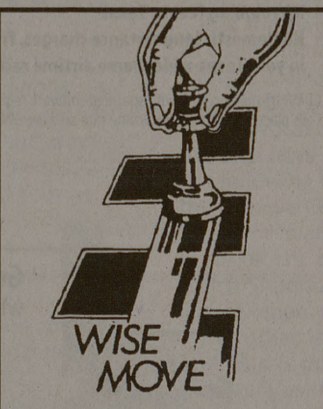

MIP and PI violations are Class C Misdemeanors and can result in a fine of up to \$500, an alcohol awareness class, community service and a 30 day suspension of your driver's license.

DWI is a Class B Misdemeanor and can result in a fine of up to \$2000, community service and a 72 hour minimum confinement. DUI may be given to minors driving with any detectable amount of alcohol in their system and is a Class C Misdemeanor.
