"I think I came to Stanford very well prepared," he said. "The core physics classes were rather easy for me, so I had more free time.'

Sokolov said he enjoys sports of all types. In California, he enjoyed wind surfing and tennis and boxed for many years in Russia. He also took classes in fencing, art, drawing, modern sculpture and piano classes.

Sokolov said most of his family still lives in Ukraine, but he resides in College Station with his wife Tonya, whom he married Now 32, Sokolov said he

hopes to continue finding possibilities to study new physics. He continues to research optics at A&M with students and coworkers.

"I am fortunate to be working with him," said graduate and coworker Andrea Burzo. "Dr. Sokolov is very helpful in everything that we do. He is constantly next to us, giving us advice. It's a really nice teacher-student relationship."

In the past, Sokolov has taught 200-level undergraduate physics classes, but he will begin

teaching senior-level labs n fall.
