San Antonio plan NBA title fiesta

SAN ANTONIO — Let the good times keep rolling. Make that "floating."

San Antonio, a city that takes Mon.-Fri. (NO its festivities seriously, has set aside Wednesday for a citywide celebration of the Spurs' second NBA championship.

The revelry will start with a barge parade along the Riverwalk in downtown San Antonio, and then adjourn for another event in the biggest room in town — the Alamodome, where the team played for nine years before moving into the new SBC Center this season.

"San Antonio throws great parties, and this will be another party to be remembered," pledged Mayor Ed Garza in a written statement.

Much of the city was nursing collective hangover Monday after whooping it up into the wee hours after the Spurs captured the championship by beating the New Jersey Nets, 88-77, on Sunday night.

Thousands of joyous Spurs fans jammed downtown San Antonio after the final buzzer to take part in the victory. Motorists inched bumper to bumper along the main thoroughfares, often with their passengers hanging out windows to thrust their fists into the humid night air or slap hands with sidewalk-bound onlookers.
