



#### Two women dead, one injured in San Antonio office shooting

SAN ANTONIO (AP) - A man who authorities believe fatally shot two women and critically wounded another in a San Antonio real estate office Wednesday later killed himself during a pursuit near Temple, police said.

The man, who still hasn't been identified by police, was fleeing from officers in a black Ford Explorer when he shot himself, San Antonio Police Sgt. Gabe Trevino said. The vehicle ended up in a

"The license plate matches the vehicle that we were looking for," he said. "The description of the suspect also matches the description of the suspect we were looking for."

Trevino wouldn't release any of the names of those involved, but said all worked at a Century 21 real estate office in northeast San Antonio near

Interstate 35. "He walked in, approached these three employees, shot them, then ran," Trevino said. He said the victims were shot multiple times, but he couldn't

say how many. The wounded woman was taken by helicopter to University Hospital with a single gunshot wound.
