# Texans find ways to remember 9-11

FORT WORTH, (AP) -From airport workers to schoolteachers, many Texans who wanted to help when terror New York and struck Washington two years ago now are focusing on remembering the victims, rescue workers and their sacrifices.

Officials Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport, are planning an elaborate ceremony dedicating a new fire station to the emerworkers gency who died during the attacks on Sept. 11, 2001.

Representatives from New York City police and

fire departments and the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey will lay a wreath at the new station. More than 300 people from the New York City Fire Department were killed after terrorists hijacked passenger airliners and flew them into the World Trade Center.

"I'm a fireman, I appreciate what those guys do," D/FW Fire Chief Alan Black told the Fort Star-Telegram

## **Grounded freighter** still awaits rescue

SABINE PASS. (AP) -Crews have finished removing fuel from a 767-foot Croatian freighter that has been stuck in the mud since Aug. 30, the Coast Guard said Wednesday.

Commander Roderick Walker told The Associated Press that workers Thursday, weather permitting, will attempt to transfer the cargo from the Peljesac to another vessel.

The fully loaded ship wa bound for Canada, haul petroleum coke, when it m into Tropical Storm Grace.

The first step was to "min mize environmental risk according to Walker, who said the offloading of the fuel was finished late Tuesday.

The next step is to unloa the ship which is stuck about 1.5 miles south of the Sabine
