Republican Party logs 1 million new donors

WASHINGTON — The donations aren't all that big — most under \$30 — but the number of people contributing to the Republican Party is a milestone: more than 1 million new donors since President Bush took office.

That beats the Republican National Committee's previous record of 853,595 first-time donors during President Reagan's two terms in the 1980s. The new contributors in Bush's tenure yielded \$55 million for the RNC, spokeswoman Christine Iverson said Wednesday.

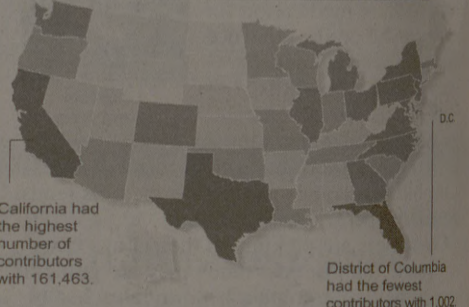
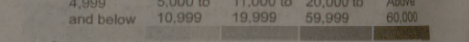
"These are not wealthy people," said Iverson, who said the typical donation was under \$30. The RNC doesn't know whether the donors gave to Republican candidates in the past, but it was their first time contributing to the national committee, she said.

In total numbers, California provided the most new donors to the party — 161,463 — followed by Florida, governed by Bush's brother, Jeb, with 76,028; and Texas, the president's home state, with 61,487. American Samoa provided the fewest: just one.

The party reached out to the contributors through a combination of mail, phones and the Internet, Iverson said.

GOP reaches milestone in donors

Republicans have broken another party fundraising record with more than 1 million first-time donors since President Bush took office in January 2001, breaking the record of the Reagan era.

Such new contributors, many of them donating modest amounts, are a key part of the parties' efforts to adapt to the campaign finance law banning corporate, union and unlimited donations that took effect last November.

Democrats, too, have been aggressively trying to attract new contributors. The Democratic National Committee has gained roughly 600,000 new donors since Bush took office in January 2001.

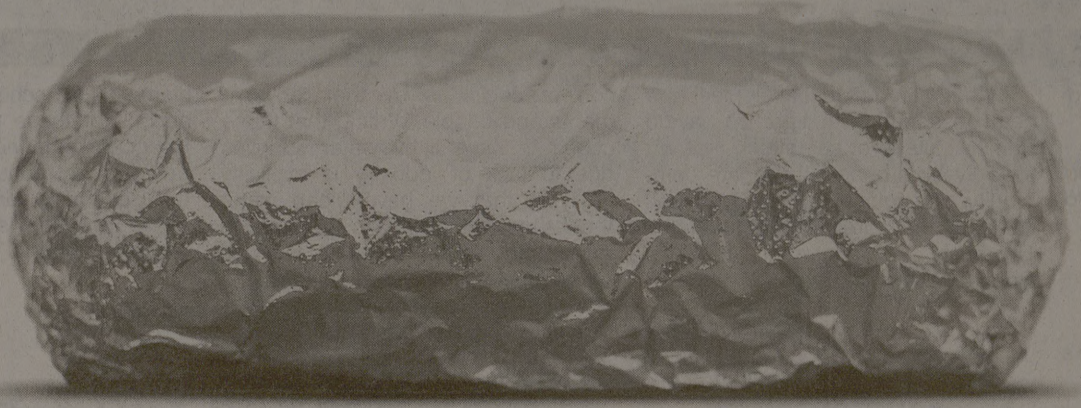

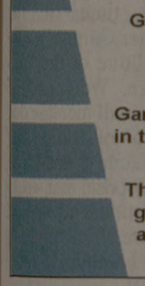
