struction boom. It took 10 hours to transport the 200-ton limestone house 160 steps to its new location between the O. Henry Museum and the soon-to-be-completed Hilton Austin.

The move, which was delayed more than two years after the house was lifted from its original foundation and placed in storage, preserves the residence of the woman known children as the most famous Anglo survivor of the Battle of the Alamo in 1836.
