

## No. 1 Texas

Two days after being voted the No. 1 women's basketball team by The Associated Press, the University of Texas (21-2, 9-1 Big 12) will play for the first time as No. 1 when they take on their rival unranked Texas A&M (8-13, 1-9) at 7 p.m. Wednesday in Austin.

The last time the two teams met, Dec. 21 in College Station, was a bitter struggle that lasted into the final minute, ending in a two-point victory for the Longhorns.

Texas head coach Jody Conradt said she expects another close game.

'I am expecting another struggle, another really competitive game," Conradt said.

She said the Aggies usually play especially hard, and they barely survived the last game.

Conradt said the Dec. 21 game was a wakeup call about her team's mental state and that since then, they have been playing better.

"I think we realized (after that game) that we needed to get our minds right," Conradt said. "We're going to have a different focus."
