After hearing a guest speaker in his broadcast journalism class, he inspired to seek an internship with the weather team at KBTX. Instead of sitting back and waiting for it to happen, Herzog took initiative and called Chief Meteorologist Bob French directly to ire about the internship.

After only three months, he was hired as a fill-in and four nths later applied for the morning show as a full-time weather-

Working 40 hours a week and taking a full-time course load hasslowed down Herzog, who has maintained a 4.0 and will graduate time this May. He is also the president of Texas A&M Student pter of the American Meteorological Society (TAMSCAMS).

"I have to be very disciplined," he said. "I knew I was making a ifice to invest for the future.

and ABC in Dallas, Isom was ready for his opportunity, going from intern to the fill-in position after only a month. He now also helps coordinate with the current interns.

Like Herzog, Isom wanted to be a weather forecaster for as long as he can remember. He recalls watching the news just to see the forecast, which later turned into a passion that he loves to share.
