The consultants may consider reorganizing bus routes and ting some services, said Log Renfrow, Southside student sen tor and junior management ma

Renfrow said stops that are used a lot, as shown by passen counts, may be eliminated.

TS and the Student Senatev evaluate whether there needs to a Transportation Fee increase af the bus consultants make their ommendations, Renfrow said.

The Transportation Fee charged to provide access for students to on- and off-camp bus service, to pay for a long-ter bus replacement plan, and to for operating expenses and t enhancement of bus facilities campus, according to the A& Division of Finance Web site.

Weis said in March, the A& System Board of Regen approved a Transportation Fe increase that will be implement in the fall. The fee will increase from \$50 to \$60 for fall, spring and 10-week summer semester and from \$25 to \$30 for five-week summer terms.

Weis said that fee increase will only be slightly helpful in puchasing new buses, which of between \$260,000 and \$300,000

"But, it gets us started," Wei said. "If we can start replaci three or four a year (buses), that three of four a year more than we've been able to replace."

Weis said the consultants wi help decide what level the te needs to be at in the future in orde to replace buses at the rate where TS will never have any buse more than 12 to 15 years old.

"The problem right now i we're spending everything w take in on service, and there' nothing left over to purchase capi-

tal," Weis said. According to the contract, the consultants officially began working for TS in April. They will not work during the summer, but will continue in the fall. The pay for the consultants is not to exceed \$41,305, said June Broughton, TS

communications manager. Weis said that ultimately To would like to get approval of five-year plan that states how many hours buses will run and how many new buses can be purchased per year.




