street one to three minutes. However, it takes seven to 10 minutes to travel the street, he said. "It's constantly stop and go," Menchaca said. The forum attendees also commented on advertising as a source of revenue. McLaren said students would have to choose between having busses that look simple and clean on the outside with no advertising and busses that have advertising on the outside and that may appear less attractive. Samantha Echols, a bus driver and senior biology major, said busses should have exterior advertisements. "We need to have advertising to get more money," she said. McLaren said public input, cost and infrastructure will be key factors in formulating the plan. Cunningham also told McLaren that she would like for all bus stops to include a shelter. She said covered bus stops could include a bulletin board for posting bus schedules. Similar forums to gather student input will be held in the fall, said Transportation Services Director Rodney Weis.
