to our organization," said Justin Silhavy, senior geography major and Conference check-in coordinator. "It gives new students the chance to socialize with others."

A member of the Aggie Orientation Leaders Program (AOLP), Silhavy said the organization's main focus this year was for the new student experience to be more personal.

"Hopefully, this goal will be fulfilled with our diverse team of orientation leaders and our mingling and discussion group strategies," he said.

The AOLP executed a new system this year to let the new students in similar groupings throughout the conference.

By randomly selecting colored bandanas, the students are divided into four groups, which are organized as teams during the games at the Aggie Energizer.

"My advisers and I came up with a program for students to find group identity within a color," said Rebecca Branom, senior psychology major and AOLP program coordinator of Freshmen Dinner and Insight.

"The program is running much smoother than last year by giving the new students something to bond with."

"Basically, the Energizer is a time for the new students to have fun, hang out and not be stressed," Branom said. "The group freshmen have shown a lot of enthusiasm cheering on their color teams."

These color groups are again separated into another four groups to learn more about campus life from the orientation leaders, and to get to know the students better during the Insight program. Insight is a series of sessions for these smaller groups to ask questions, learn about campus life, and bond with orientation leaders and group members.

"When I was at Insight during my freshman conference all I remember is sitting in the hallway asking questions," Branom said. "This year has been much more personal. We are really making an effort to get to know the new students."

For some incoming freshmen, this more personal tactic seems to have worked.

"After the orientation programs, I feel like I'm supposed to be here," said incoming freshman Jenna Price. "I feel like I belong."

On average, each conference welcomes 650 new students to AggieLand and 81 percent of freshmen bring at least one family member with them, said Hernandez. With such a large number of students and parents in attendance, it is important to make everyone feel welcome.

"I was definitely reassured with choosing to come to A&M," Price said. "I'm really excited about all the friendships and bonds to be made by becoming part of the Aggie community."
