**Coach K will stay at Duke University**  
 DURHAM, N.C. (AP) — Coach Krzyzewski is staying at Duke University after ending talks with the Los Angeles Lakers about becoming their coach.  
 "Your heart has to be where whatever you want to do," Krzyzewski said Monday. "The decision was somewhat difficult to make because you have to follow your heart and lead it and Duke has always been up my whole heart."  
 Krzyzewski, who has won three national titles at Duke, said the timing of the offer and their prominence as one of professional sports' most famous franchises made the chance to coach tempting. But he never got to the point of being ready to leave.  
 Krzyzewski said Lakers general manager Mitch Kupchak made his interest in Krzyzewski clear during negotiations the two had around the time of the NBA draft. Kupchak met with Krzyzewski in North Carolina last Thursday to discuss the job.  
 Lakers star Kobe Bryant reportedly involved in trying to persuade Coach K to take the job.

**Elvis fans celebrate 50th anniversary**  
 MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — Elvis Presley's "That's All Right" played simultaneously on radio stations around the world Monday to mark the 50th anniversary of the rock-and-roll icon's first professional recording.  
 Scotty Moore, Presley's guitarist, hit a button on a button board at Sun Studio to begin the satellite broadcast, 1,200 to 1,500 stations.  
 Outside the small studio where Presley cut the record on July 5, 1954, a street party was under way, with bands performing on a sound stage Sun's front door. More than 2,000 participants turned up by early afternoon.  
 "That's All Right" now is a prominent place in the history of American music, but it was an immediate hit.  
 "A lot of people think it's an overnight success, but we paid our dues for two years on the road in Mississippi, Arkansas, Tennessee, before RCA picked up Moore said.

**Kerry edges closer to picking VP**  
 WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. John Edwards interrupted Walt Disney World vacation last week to meet with Democratic presidential candidate John Kerry, adding a level of intrigue to the presidential search.  
 Kerry must nominate a presidential candidate at the Democratic Convention, which begins in Boston on July 26.  
 The Massachusetts senator said Monday he had not yet chosen a nominee, but that he would stop the rampant speculation in Democratic circles.  
 "I've made no decision at this point in time, and I'm going to continue to keep it a private personal process until I announce it publicly," the senator told WTAE, an ABC affiliate in Pittsburgh. Since the search began in March, Kerry's name has been disclosed almost constantly about his list of candidates, their interviews and his winning choice.  
 Edwards, a polished politician from North Carolina, outstepped all but Kerry in the Democratic primary and is the favorite of many party regulars. Two weeks ago, speaking on condition of anonymity, said Edwards disrupted a family vacation in Florida to meet with Kerry.
