"It would be better if it was free," she said.

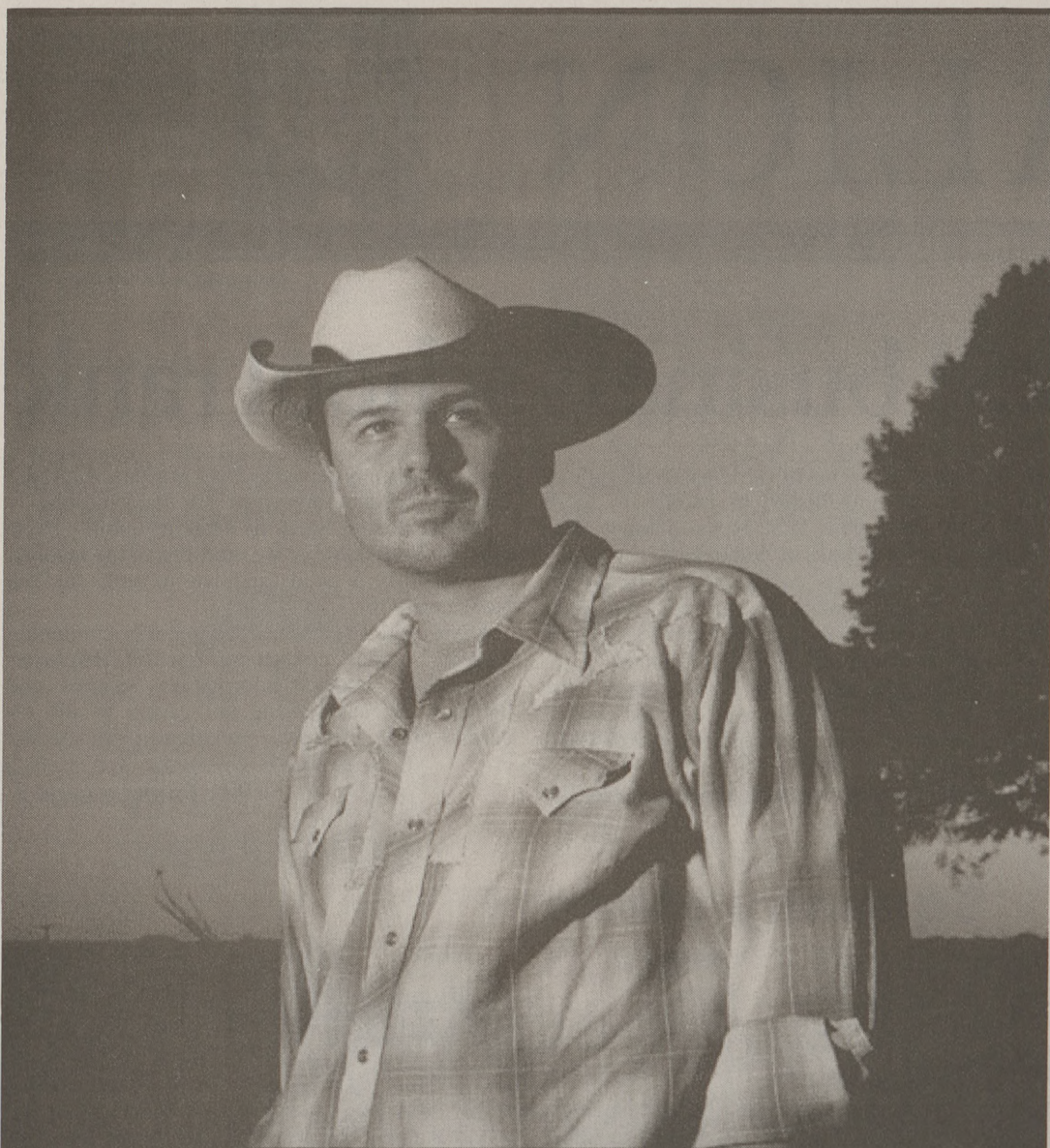
Harness said she would rather pay the \$5 to park her vehicle than have someone drop her off and pick her up.
